To Whom It May Concern:

As owners and operators of an equestrian property with several ponds, we have struggled for a number of years with a frustrating wild goose problem. Every spring, we had many geese colonizing on our ponds and in our paddocks. The geese made the area outside of our stable and sand ring very messy, and the horses were often unsettled by their noise and activities. We had tried numerous methods to discourage the geese from congregating but were unable to make any impact on their behaviour. We also had quite a growing population as the geese were breeding and producing offspring that would return each spring as adults.

This spring we engaged Bye Bye Birdie Goose Control Services Ltd. to give us some guidance with our goose problem. The staff responded quickly, evaluated our situation, and developed a tailored plan to address our problem. We were impressed by their knowledge of goose behaviour, sensitivity to our property and what impact different goose control methods could potentially have on our horses. Staff was also knowledgeable and professional in obligations involving the Canadian Wildlife Service and the acquisition of required permits.

The net result of our involvement with Bye Bye Birdie is that we have **no** geese congregating on the ponds near the stable area, in the paddocks or on the pond behind our house, and we have received the training and tools to continue to control the geese ourselves in the future. The program developed for our farm has been a complete success and we feel that the results have more than justified the fees charged by Bye Bye Birdie.
